## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

## KATO FOUNDATION

Article One: The name of the Corporation is Kato Foundation

Article Two: The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

Article Three: The specific purposes for which said Corporation is formed are all within the purview of Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and the Regulations there under:

(a) To rescue abandoned cats and dogs.

(b) To provide food, shelter and medical care to abandoned cats and dogs.

Article Four: This Corporation is organized pursuant to the General Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of Texas.

Article Five: The number of directors of this Corporation shall be three.

Article Six: The names and addresses of the directors are:

Article Eight: This Corporation is organized for non-profit purposes; no part of any earnings or assets thereof shall be distributed to the directors or any other individual.

Article Nine: In the event of the dissolution of this Corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts or obligations of this Corporation, the directors, or persons in charge of liquidation, shall grant, convey, assign and transfer the remaining assets of this corporation unto a charitable foundation organized and operated exclusively for the prevention of cruelty to children or animals.

Article Ten: The Corporation and its directors shall at all times abide and be governed by the Bylaws of this Corporation.
